RESOLUTION RATIFYING AND AUTHORIZING REVISIONS BY THE CITY OF WINSTON-SALEM AND COUNTY OF FORSYTH TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT PROVIDING THE APPOINTMENT PROCESS OF THE DIRECTOR OF THE CITY-COUNTY OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

WHEREAS, in response to questions regarding the appointment process and supervision of the Emergency Management Director, pursuant to the provisions of N.C.G.S. 166A-19.15, the UNC School of Government issued a legal opinion which necessitates changes in the local process of appointment, supervision, and termination;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners hereby ratifies and authorizes revisions to the interlocal agreement between City of Winston-Salem and Forsyth County, regarding the appointment process, supervision, and termination of the Director of the City-County Office of Emergency Management, consistent with the legal opinion of the UNC School of Government interpreting the provisions of N.C.G.S. 166A-19.15 as follows:

Section 4.a. The Director shall be recommended by the City Manager and appointed by and responsible to the Winston-Salem City Council and Forsyth County Board of Commissioners. The Director shall be supervised by the City Manager and may be disciplined or terminated by recommendation of the City Manager upon agreement of the City Council and Board of Commissioners.
