**EXPLANATION:**

The purpose of this amendment is to close-out the 2008 Pay-Go Capital Projects Ordinance and re-appropriate funds from projects not started and residual savings from completed projects to the 2013 Pay-Go Capital Projects Ordinance. In addition, interest earnings are appropriated and transferred to the 2013 Pay-Go Capital Projects Ordinance as Residual Equity.

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**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FORSYTH COUNTY THAT THE 2008 PAY-GO CAPITAL PROJECTS ORDINANCE IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:**

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**2013 Pay-Go  
Capital Projects Ordinance**

Be It Ordained by the Board of County Commissioners of Forsyth County:

Section 1. Revenue.

The following revenues are hereby made available by the closing of two Pay-Go Capital Projects Ordinances and re-appropriating the unused funds and/or residual projects to the 2013 Pay-Go Capital Projects Ordinance.

Transfer from the 2008 Pay-Go Capital Projects Ordinance	\$378,223.33
Transfer from the 2010 Pay-Go Capital Projects Ordinance	<u>\$228,432.78</u>
Total	<u>\$606,656.11</u>

Section 2. Authorization for Projects and Appropriation of Funds.

Be It Ordained that the following projects are hereby authorized in concept and the following amounts are hereby appropriated for capital renovations and purchase of equipment for the following projects, subject to review by the Board of County Commissioners of the plan for each project, compliance with applicable bidding laws, and final award or authorization by the Board of County Commissioners of specific contracts for each project as required by law or the Budget Ordinance; and the County Manager, Clerk to the Board and Chief Financial Officer are hereby authorized to execute the necessary documents to carry out these purposes, subject to the limitations herein, a pre-audit certificate thereon by the Chief Financial Officer, if applicable, and the approval as to form and legality by the County Attorney.

Be It Further Ordained that the following projects were previously established in the 2008 Pay-Go Capital Projects Ordinance or the 2010 Pay-Go Capital Projects Ordinance and are being transferred to the 2013 Pay-Go Capital Projects Ordinance for accounting purposes.
