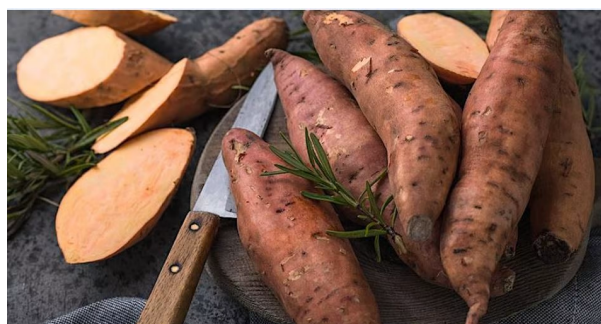

## N.C. AGRICULTURE COST SHARE FUNDS

The Forsyth Soil and Water Conservation District has received an allocation from the state for non-point source pollution control resulting from agricultural activities. These funds are available to assist farmers with the installation of conservation practices that help decrease the amount of sediment, nitrogen, phosphorus, and other pollutants in the surface and ground water of the state. ### Soil Test Fees to Begin

Most of the year (generally April through November), routine NCDA&CS soil tests are provided at "no direct cost" to N.C. residents because of funding derived from a statewide fee on commercial fertilizer. From Thanksgiving through March, however, a peak-season fee of \$4 is charged for the processing of all soil samples. Mail your samples to arrive before Thanksgiving to avoid the \$4 fee. Soil test boxes, forms and brochures are available anytime outside our office in the message center located at the corner of our demonstration garden.
