Soil Test Fees

Most of the year (generally April through November), routine NCDA&CS soil tests are provided at "no direct cost" to N.C. residents because of funding derived from a statewide fee on commercial fertilizer. From Thanksgiving through March, however, a peak-season fee of \$4 is charged for the processing of all soil samples. Soil test boxes, forms and brochures are available anytime outside our office in the message center located at the corner of our demonstration garden.
