REGISTRATION FORM - LAND CLEARING OPEN BURNING

Instructions

1. In accordance with Forsyth County Air Quality Technical Code (FCAQTC) Rule 3D .0202, this form is for registering *land clearing open burning activities, including the use of air curtain burners.*
2. This registration must be submitted to the Forsyth County Office of Environmental Assistance and Protection at least seven (7) days before the anticipated initiation of the open burning. An in-office visit with open burning staff is necessary. You may bring this form with you when you come.
3. Open burning of land clearing debris is prohibited in Forsyth County unless **all** of the following requirements are met:
 - ✓ The wind direction at the time that the burning is initiated and as forecasted by the National Weather Service during the time of the burning are away from any area which may be affected by smoke, ash, or other air pollutants from the burning.
 - ✓ The location of the burning is at least 1,000 feet from any dwelling, group of dwellings, or commercial or institutional establishment, or other occupied structure not located on the property on which the burning is conducted.
 - ✓ Only land cleared plant growth is burned (kerosene, distillate oil, or diesel fuel may be used to start the fire).
 - ✓ Initial burning begins only between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., and no combustible material is added to the fire between 6:00 p.m. on one day and 8:00 a.m. on the following day.
 - ✓ No open burning is allowed on days with air quality forecasts of code “orange”, “red” or “purple.”
 - ✓ No fires are started or vegetation is added to existing fires when the Division of Forest Resources has banned burning for that area.
 - ✓ The material to be burned must originate from the land being cleared or the area being maintained.
4. Registration of land clearing open burning activities does not provide approval or any determination by the Department that the proposed open burning activity will meet the exceptions to the open burning prohibition under FCAQTC Rule 3D .1903(b)(2).
5. Failure to register or satisfy all the exceptions will be considered violations of the FCAQTC subject to enforcement action including civil penalties not to exceed \$10,000 per violation per day.

A Permit must be obtained from the North Carolina Division of Forest Resources prior to any burning. A permit from Forest Resources does not exempt you from the provisions of the Air Quality Regulations.
