The funding period for these funds is January 1, 2020 through May 31, 2020, if all funds are not utilized, NCDHHS has allowed remaining funds to be spent in FY21 (June 1, 2020 through May 31, 2021)

Funds will be used for staff overtime, to purchase equipment and supplies, provide contractual services, temporary help and for travel expenses related to trainings related to COVID-19 response.
