


2015 Walk A Mile to Save Our Babies

Registration begins at 11:00 a.m.; Program begins at 11:30 am - 1:30 pm



- Parking** Parking is available directly across from Centenary UMC on 5th St.
- Dress** Thanks to a generous donation by Forsyth County NC Baby Love Plus t-shirts for the event have been provided, however they are available on a *first come first served basis*, please wear a **pink** or **blue** shirt in case you do not receive a provided t-shirt. Please wear comfortable walking shoes for this “moving” tribute.
- Strollers** Strollers are provided by the event organizer; there is no need to bring your own. We will walk with 37 empty strollers to recognize those babies lost. Participants without strollers will walk to show their support of the cause. There will also be poster signs to carry along the route and literature available to distribute to passing pedestrians.
- The Route** We will begin at the steps of Centenary UMC, travel down 5th St., turn right on Trade St., right on 4th St., right on Poplar St., and end by making a left on 4½ St. and enter Centenary UMC Banquet Hall, a planning comm. member will be available to collect strollers prior to entering the hall.
- The Program** Registration begins at 11am at the steps of Centenary UMC (arrive early to get a t-shirt), the program will begin at 11:30am, followed by the walk at approximately 12 noon with the second portion of the program and lunch to start in the church auditoriuml at 12:30 pm, we will end no later than 1:30 pm.
