


Ways to vote

Absentee By-Mail



Request an absentee ballot **by 5:00 p.m. on October 29th**. Absentee ballots must be returned to the Board of Elections office by **November 5th at 7:30 p.m**. Download the form at <u>www.fcvotes.com</u>.

Early Voting



Early Voting will be held from **October 17th to November 2nd.** Check online at <u>www.fcvotes.com</u> for time and sites.

You can also register to vote or update your voter information (except party affiliation) during Early Voting.

At the polls on Election Day



Polls are open on Election Day, November 5th, 6:30 a.m. – 7:30 p.m.

Deadlines



October 11th by 5:00 p.m.

Last day to register to vote, or update your address, name, or party.

If you move, your polling place may change. Be sure to update your voter registration address every time you move.

October 29th by 5:00 p.m

Last day to request an absentee ballot by mail.

November 2nd by 3:00 p.m.

Last day to vote Early Voting. Check online at <u>www.fcvotes.com</u> for the list of sites.



All Voting Sites are Handicap Accessible

Who May Assist a Voter?

- Near relatives, including, spouse, parent, child, sibling, grandparent, grandchild, in-law, stepparent and stepchild
- Others, except for those listed below, may assist the voter ONLY IF the voter is blind, disabled, or illiterate
- Poll workers may assist any voter

Who May NOT Assist a Voter?

- Voter's employer
- Agent of the voter's employer
- Officer or agent of the voter's union
- Anyone by telephone

Curbside Voting


If you are unable to enter the voting place because of age or physical disability, you may vote from your vehicle. Alert a precinct official of your desire to vote in this manner.





What to expect at the polls

When you arrive, precinct officials will be there to help you.




If you are not on the voter list, an election official may direct you to vote a provisional ballot.

To vote on a paper ballot



Make your selection by filling in the oval next to your choice(s).




Review and insert your ballot into the tabulator

To vote on a touchscreen



Make your selections on the screen.
