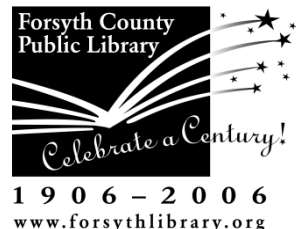

PAC – the Library Catalog

The Public Access Catalog (PAC) is available at all Library locations. PACs provide a catalog of Library holdings and enable customers to access their account information and place holds on materials. Internet access is not allowed.

Assistive Technology Stations (Central, Carver, Kernersville)

Assistive Technology Stations offer customers with disabilities (visual, hearing and some physical) free access to adaptive computers and software. Special software programs for customers who are blind or have low vision, and work stations that can accommodate wheelchairs, are designed to help eliminate barriers that limit access to technology. Customers must receive an orientation to use these computers.

Children's Computers

Children's computers containing educational software, early literacy software and the Internet are available for children 13 and under and for developmentally disabled adults. Software varies by Library location.

Express (Central, Kernersville, Reynolda)

The Express computers are available on a first come, first served basis. Their intended purpose is to allow visitors and cardholders to check email, print out a document, or perform other quick tasks. The time limit is 15 minutes and counts toward the three hour time allotment for the day. After using the Express computers, users are locked out of signing up for any other computer for a period of fifteen minutes.

Research Computers at Central Library

Time may be reserved for two hours the current day or for the next day the library is open. Computer reservations are held for a 15 minute grace period. A customer who has used a computer for two hours must leave the station if another customer is waiting. The customer may stay one additional hour if no other customer needs the computer. Customers are limited to a total of three hours of computer use per day.

General Research

Customers may sign up for designated research computers if they are conducting any work or study (examples: job search, school work or business-related research).

NC History, Genealogy & Documents

Computers dedicated to researching North Carolina topics including history and genealogy are available in the North Carolina Room. These computers are also available for researching Federal and State documents.

Nonprofit Research

A computer to be used by customers who are researching the nonprofit sector is available in the Nonprofit Research Center. This computer may also be used by anyone affiliated with a designated 501 © 3 nonprofit to do work associated with the nonprofit.
