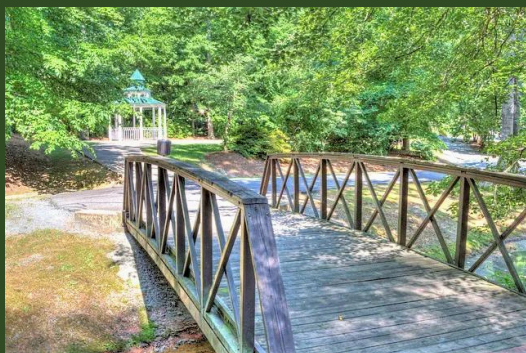

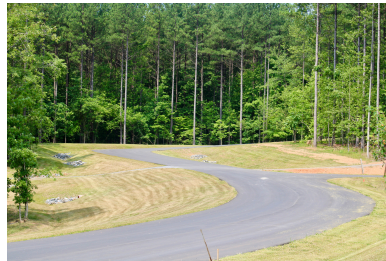
Welcome!

J. Dudley Watts, Jr. Forsyth County Belews Lake Park



The new Belews Lake Park will be named after retiring Forsyth County Manager Dudley Watts, who has provided 17 years of service to Forsyth County. The new park, which is regionally located in the Belews Lake Community, is situated on the edge of Belews Lake. The J. Dudley Watts Jr. Forsyth County Belews Lake Park boasts a total of 216 acres that will provide new recreational opportunities in a rural community. With nearly two miles of shoreline, a lengthy multi-use trail system, a reservable picnic shelter, and a fishing pier, Forsyth County is looking forward to the GRAND OPENING of this park later this Summer!
