## CONTEST REQUIREMENTS

### JUDGING CRITERIA

- Compliance with all eligibility, submission instructions, and artwork specifications
- Visual appeal, creativity, and understandability
- No political endorsement
- **Optional** theme ideas
  - Forsyth County History
  - Places that shaped our identity
  - Events important to our story
  - What makes NC unique

### Timeline

- Submissions open **February 6<sup>th</sup>** and close **March 6<sup>th</sup> at 5p.m.**
- Finalists Selected **April 16<sup>th</sup>**
- Public voting opens **April 20<sup>th</sup>** and closes **May 11<sup>th</sup>**
- **Winner Announced May 21<sup>st</sup>**
- **Sticker used in: November 2026 General Election**

### Eligibility

- Must be **18 years old or younger**
- Must be a **Forsyth County resident**
- Must be enrolled in a **Forsyth County school or homeschool program**

### Submission Instructions

- Each submission must include:
  - **Signed release form**
  - Completed **submission form**
- Optional: Brief description of design

## Artwork Specifications

- **Original artwork only**
- No copyrighted images, logos, characters, or brand names
- Must include the phrase **“I Voted”**
- Must be **non-partisan** (no promotion of parties, candidates, or issues)
- May include imagery related to **Forsyth County / North Carolina**
- **Sticker size:** 1.5 inches (diameter)
- **Background:** White paper
- **Accepted media:** Pencil, ink, crayons, markers, pastels, or paint (*AI-generated artwork is not permitted*)
- No offensive or inappropriate content
