March 2, 2026 – 2:00 p.m.

Meeting Called to Order

A meeting of the Forsyth County Board of Elections was called to order in the 2nd Floor Board Room on Monday, March 2, 2026 at 2:08 p.m., Chairperson A.L. Collins presiding.

Pledge of Allegiance

Chairperson A.L. Collins led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Moment of Silence

Chairperson A.L. Collins led a moment of silence.

Public Comments

Chairperson A.L. Collins called for public comments, providing two minutes per speaker:

Secretary Doomy moved to close public comments; Member Harvey seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Motion to Approve Meeting Agenda

Chairperson Collins asked for a motion to approve the agenda. Secretary Doomy moved to approve the agenda; Member Draper seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Approval of Absentee Ballots

1 spoiled civilian absentee ballot

Secretary Doomy moved to disapprove the spoiled ballot; Member Draper seconded. **Motion**

carried unanimously.

1 pending civilian absentee ballot with photo ID verification

Vice Chair Jourdan moved to approve the pending ballot that photo ID verification had been provided for; Member Draper seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

2 pending civilian absentee ballots with photo ID verification in which a husband and wife accidentally swapped return envelopes.

Vice Chair Jourdan moved to approve the ballots as presented; Member Draper seconded. **Motin carried unanimously.**

Approval of Certified Absentee and Early Voting List

Board Members signed absentee voter reports for the approved and disapproved ballots.

Board Members signed Zero Reports for the DS450 high-speed scanner.

Board Members signed the certified absentee lists.

Appointment of Election Day Precinct Officials

Director Tsujii presented the list of election day precinct officials to serve on the March 3, 2026, Primary Election. Due to the unprecedented number of last-minute vacancies, emergency judges have been assigned to fill said vacancies. Member Draper moved to approve the precinct officials as presented; Member Harvey seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Appointment of Election Day Observers

Tricia Starkey, Board Clerk, presented the observers for the Democratic and Republican Parties for Election Day. Vice Chair Jourdan moved to approve the observers for both parties as presented; Secretary Doomy seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Other Business

**Mr. Tsujii presented tow voter challenges for individuals that voted during early voting and have active felony status as directed by Numbered Memo 2022-05.

Secretary Doomy moved to challenge the vote for Mr. Carter; Member Draper seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Secretary Doomy moved to challenge the vote for Mr. Jeffrey; Member Harvey seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

**Mr. Tsujii informed the Board of issues with All My Son's Moving Company that is contracted to deliver supplies to the precincts. Three drivers were late and 1 called off and the company did not have additional manpower to fill the need for truck drivers. Supplies for election day are being delivered but behind scheduled. Additionally, one truck broke down and there was a delay for a replacement vehicle. Board member discussed the details of the contract with All My Son's Moving Company with Member Draper stating that liquidity damages and additional employment costs should be look at for future contracts.

**Mr. Tsujii informed the Boad that precincts 506 and 302 do not have heating as of this morning. The heating has been fixed at precinct 506 and industrial-sized heaters are being taken to precinct 302.

**Ms. Starkey reviewed the schedule and agenda for the meeting the following day.
