March 6, 2026 – 9:00 a.m.

Meeting Called to Order

A meeting of the Forsyth County Board of Elections was called to order in the 2nd Floor Board Room on Friday, March 6, 2026 at 9:01 a.m., Chairperson A.L. Collins presiding.

Macy Payne, Absentee Ballot Manager, presented one civilian absentee ballot which had been cured by the voter. Vice Chair Jourdan moved to approve the ballot; Member Draper seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Review of Provisional Disposition

Kay Moore, Voter Registration Manager, presented the provisional ballots disposition as follows: 118 approved status, 105 partial count status, 143 disapproved status, and 45 pending status.

Vice Chair Jourdan moved to approve 118 provisional ballots; Member Harvey seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Member Draper moved to accept 105 partial approval provisional ballots; Member Harvey seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Member Draper moved to disapprove 143 provisional ballots; Member Harvey seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Recess: Chairperson Collins called for recess at 9:56 a.m.

Reconvene: Chairperson Collins reconvened the meeting at 10:21 a.m.

Mr. Tsujii presented the updated provisional disposition numbers to the Board as follows: 144 approved status, 105 partially counted status, 143 disapproved status, and 45 pending status.

Member Draper moved to approve the updated totals as presented; Vice Chair Jourdan seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Other Business

Mr. Tsujii informed the Board that a voter passed away on February 27, 2026 and had voted an early voting ballot on February 13, 2026. Member Draper moved to challenge the ballot cast; Member Harvey seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Review of Provisional Disposition after 12:00 p.m.

Mr. Tsujii presented to the Board 17 pending status provisional ballots that the voters had until noon today to provide the required information. All voters were contacted.

One pending provisional ballot missing photo ID and signature was presented to the board. Secretary Doomy moved to disapprove the provisional ballot; Member Draper seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Three pending provisional ballots from voters identified in the Voter Registration Repair Project that did not include the required DL/SSN numbers on the provisional application, nor checked the box on the application indicating they did not have either number, were presented to the Board. Secretary Doomy moved to disapprove the provisional ballots; Member Draper seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Twelve provisional ballots missing photo ID were presented to the Board. These voters chose to bring their photo ID in person to our office until 12 pm today but did not. Secretary Doomy moved to disapprove the 12 provisional ballots; Member Draper seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

One voter appeared in person and provided their photo ID as required. Secretary Doomy moved to approve the provisional ballot for this voter; Member Draper seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Mr. Tsujii presented the updated provisional ballots disposition numbers as follows: 146 approved status, 161 disapproved status, and 107 partially counted status (see attachment). Vice Chair Jourdan moved to approve the provisional ballot totals as presented; Member Draper seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**
